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# **Report IN-HOUSE TRAINING (based on Perpignan trainings)**

**“WELCOME - Towards incoming international university communities”**



In September 16, 2019, the Department of International Cooperation held a seminar based on material of trainings in Perpignan in June 2019 by the “WELCOME: Opening Up Towards International University Communities” project, Erasmus+ project.



The seminar was attended by coordinators responsible for international activities at faculties and departments who are in close contact with students and teachers in both inbound and outbound mobility (Faculty of Economics, Faculty of Architecture and Construction, Philology faculty, Faculty of Heat Engineering Faculty, Faculty of Law, Faculty of Social Science, Faculty of International Relations).



During the seminar, Karmelyuk Anastassiya and Madyarbekova Aiym shared their experiences gained from trainings on the internationalization of higher education institutions, which were held at the University of Perpignan.

The institutional coordinator of the Erasmus+ program at L.N. Gumilyov Eurasian National University Karmelyuk Anastassiya also explained the main goals and objectives of the Erasmus+ program International Credit Mobility component, the procedures for concluding agreements for the implementation of credit mobility for both students and teachers. The presentation also included questions about financial issues, search of the partners, monitoring of students during their academic mobility. The participants also discussed the role of students as ambassadors to university-partners.

Moreover, questions were raised regarding the academic recognition of credit mobility results. Besides we explained how to search partners for the ICM projects based on experience of Faculties of Economics, Philology, etc.



Recall that the project "WELCOME" is being implemented at L.N. Gumilyov Eurasian National University since October 2016. The main goal of the project is to strengthen the international direction and strengthen internationalization in higher educational institutions of Kazakhstan and China.

As a result of the project, since September 2018, the WELCOME Center has been functioning at ENU, which is the main center for the integration of the foreign community into the academic and socio-cultural environment of the university, as well as the International Information Reception Zone.
